
# We need your help!

#### **2018 Awards and Grants**

#### **ENS Research Award (\$1000)**

- To support development of a clinical project or independent research study to address needs of endocrine patients
- Recipients will be expected to present a poster outlining their work at ENS symposium in 2019
- Duration of grant is one year but grantees can apply for an extension for the 2nd year

Application deadline is January 15, 2018

### Poster Award (up to \$500)

- Members are encouraged to submit abstracts for poster display at the Endocrine Society's Annual meeting
- Submission must be done through the Endocrine Society's website, but please submit under "Endocrine Nursing" category in order to be considered for this award.

Deadline for submission is **November 6, 2017** 

#### **Betsy Love McClung Award (\$1500)**

In memorandum of a founding member. Award to a nurse with similar achievements to Betsy, who has made an outstanding contribution to endocrine nursing through education, research, publications, quality of patient care.

Application deadline is February 1, 2018
